## TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The above-entitled matter came on before the undersigned Judge of the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts on Plaintiff Massachusetts Lobstermen's Association, Inc.'s Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, Preliminary Injunction and Stay pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 705 against Defendants Gina Raimondo, Janey Coit, and National Marine Fisheries Service. Plaintiff was represented by Samuel Blatchley, Esq., Daniel J. Cragg, and Robert T.

Dube Jr., Esq. Defendants were represented by The Court, being duly
advised in the premises, makes the following:
<u>ORDER</u>
1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff Massachusetts Lobstermen's Association
Inc.'s Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order be, and the same is, <b>GRANTED.</b>
2. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants Gina Raimondo, Janet Coit, and Nationa
Marine Fisheries Services, be, and are, <b>ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED</b> as follows:
a. Defendants' "Final Rule to Close the Wedge Area within the Massachusetts
Restricted Area" be stayed until the resolution of Plaintiff's motion for
preliminary injunction and stay;
b. Defendants shall not promulgate another "Final Rule to Close the Wedge Area
within the Massachusetts Restricted Area" unless and until this Court has ruled
that Defendants are empowered to do so under the Marine Mammal Protection
Act, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023, and any other applicable law.
3. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall show cause, if any there
be, before the undersigned Judge of U.S. District Court, 1 Courthouse Way, Boston
Massachusetts 02210, in a courtroom to be determined at o'clockm. on the
day of 2024, why a Preliminary Injunction and Stay pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 705
of like purport and effect as this Temporary Restraining Order should not be issued for the
pendency of this action.
