ORDER AND INJUNCTION

The above-entitled matter came on for hearing before the undersigned Judge of U.S. District Court on Defendants Massachusetts Lobstermen's Association Inc. and Arthur Sawyer, for a Pre-Filing Injunction against Plaintiff Richard Maximus Strahan (a/k/a Man Against Xtinction/M.A.X.). Plaintiff appeared *pro se*. Defendant was represented by Samuel Blatchley, Esq. The Court, being duly advised in the premises, makes the following:

ORDER AND INJUNCTION

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants Massachusetts Lobstermen's Association Inc. and Arthur Sawyer's Motion for a Pre-Filing Injunction be, and the same is, **GRANTED**.

- 2. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Richard Maximus Strahan (a/k/a Man Against Xtinction/M.A.X.) be, and he is, **ENJOINED** as follows:
 - a. Plaintiff must seek and obtain leave of Court by motion before commencing or attempting to commence any civil action in this or any other U.S. District Court against the Massachusets Lobsterman's Association ("MLA"), or any officer or employee of the MLA named in his or her individual or official capacity, or against Arthur Sawyer.
 - b. In seeking leave to file, Plaintiff must certify that the claim or claims he wishes to present are new claims, never before raised and disposed of on the merits by any court.
 - c. Plaintiff must also certify that the claim or claims are not frivolous or made in bad faith.
 - d. Plaintiff must caption the motion for leave to file as "Application Pursuant to Court Order Seeking Leave to File." The Clerk of Court shall docket the motion as a miscelaneous action.
- 3. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall mail a copy of this Order and Injunction to Plaintiff.
- 4. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS INJUNCTION MAY RESULT IN YOU BEING HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND A REFERRAL MAY BE MADE FOR A CRIMINAL CONTEMPT OF COURT PROSECUTION. ANY ACTION COMMENCED IN VIOLATION OF THIS INJUNCTION SHALL BE SUMMARILY DISMISSED WITH

PREJUDICE, AND COSTS, ATTORNEYS FEES, AND OTHER MONETARY SANCTIONS MAY BE AWARDED AGAINST YOU.
